Public notice pursuant to S15 of *Marine Parks Regulations 2017 (Qld)*

Proposal to upgrade the boating facilities at Stanage Bay

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) has applied to the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority (GBRMPA) and Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service (QPWS) for permission to undertake works to upgrade the boating facilities at Stanage Bay, north of Rockhampton in the Habitat Protection Management Area of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park and Great Barrier Reef Coast Marine Park.

The upgrade of the existing Stanage Bay boat ramp (approximately 150km north of Rockhampton) includes a precast concrete boat ramp consisting of two (2) 4m wide lanes (tide restricted), a 2.5m wide floating walkway lane located on the western side of the upgraded boat ramp (tide restricted) and a rock groyne located on the eastern side of the upgraded boat ramp. The full extent of the works proposed is contained within the following GPS coordinates.
